More than 200 people attended the Bedford Historical Society's fundraiser on July 11th at Daisy Hill Farm. The event was held to commemorate the 230th anniversary of the Burning of Bedford by the British and was held below the field where lookouts first encountered the British in 1779.

The event included a dramatic Revolutionary War re-enactment by more than 60 participants, a spectacular bonfire and cocktails by torchlight. All proceeds benefit the Historical Society's properties fund which is used to maintain the historical buildings in and around the Village.
